

FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



Dear Friends,

In 2016, we celebrated 28 years of serving our Central Texas neighbors in need. With your help, we provided 25,424 individuals with high-quality, affordable dental care, emergency food and clothing assistance, adult education classes and back-to-school necessities. Manos de Cristo's life changing programs remain a critical resource to thousands of children, adults and seniors who are striving to create a brighter future.

Highlights from our programs include:

- -Our Dental Center served nearly 16,000 patients and donated \$3.9 million in dental services to the public, an 11% increase in dollars donated over 2015.
- -For the second year in a row, the Manos Education program has expanded. In 2016 we offered English as a Second Language and Citizenship classes at two satellite locations.
- We collaborated with local area farms, including Coyote Creek Farm, who donated 405 dozen of fresh eggs for our food pantry.

We are proud of how much Manos de Cristo has grown over the years and we are excited to see what 2017 has in store. We will continue creating more smiles and changing more lives with your support. Your investment in our community will make it a better place for all.



Manos de Cristo offers English as a Second Language, Computer Literacy, Citizenship, and Spanish Literacy classes (Plazas Comunitarias) to help improve work, communication, and life skills. Upon completion of our program, students can pass citizenship exams, communicate online, improve their English, and receive primary and secondary certificates in Spanish. We offer child care services and bus passes to students. Our volunteers and students work together and learn together to open doors to new possibilities.

BACK-TO-SCHOOL




SHAPING LIVES

During the program each child receives a new backpack, two new outfits, socks and underwear, school supplies, and books.


