The year 2017 marked 29 years of Manos de Cristo offering life-changing programs to our community members. With the many changes that have occured through the years, one thing remains consistent - our mission to provide high-quality, affordable dental care, emergency food and clothing assistance, adult education classes and back-to-school necessities. In 2017, our organization served **28,573** of our Central Texas neighbors in need. With your help, Manos de Cristo's life changing programs remain a critical resource to thousands of children, adults and seniors who are striving to create a brighter future and who believe in a better life for themselves and their families.

2017 accomplishments include:

- -Accommodating more patients by extending Dental Center hours of service by 26 hours per week, thus serving over 17,000 patients!
- -For the third year in a row, the Manos Education program has expanded. In 2017 we offered four new morning classes at our satellite location.
- The Food Pantry collaborated with local area churches who donated 180 bags of groceries, which totaled to 380 pounds of food!




## BACK-TO-SCHOOL Academic Readiness


