FROM OUR Executive Director

Dear Friends and Supporters,

Manos de Cristo has been helping Central Texans for over thirty five years, and we would not have been able to serve in the way that we do if it weren't for your generosity. With your continued support Manos will deliver quality dental care, education classes, and basic needs services to those most vulnerable in our community. As prices continued to soar in 2023, we saw a great increase in need.

Our Dental Center continued to expand, and offered services to MAP patients, as well as added new procedures making Manos de Cristo a dental home for many. Our patients continue to receive quality care, are treated with dignity and respect, and do not have to consider dental care a luxury.

We have observed a rise in multi-generational households seeking food and clothing assistance. To keep our Basic Needs department well-stocked, we depend on donations from individuals, local churches, and community organizations. Throughour collaboration with local churches, we received over

26,383 pounds of food! These partnerships have enabled our Food Pantry visitors to access high-quality food products, including fresh fruits and vegetables, as well as essential hygiene items such as bath soap, shampoo, and toothpaste.

In 2023, Manos de Cristo continued to offer online classes and began holding inperson classes once again. Our Education classes continued to teach new skills to 532 adult learners. Our classes included English as a Second Language (ESL), Basic Computer Skills, and Citizenship classes. We continued to offer online classes, which allowed for volunteer teachers and students to join from all over the world! 2023 SNAPSHOT



Manos de Cristo was excited to host an in-person version of the Backto-School (BTS) program after being unable to for 3 years! We also collaborated with local community organizations and school counselors to distribute backpacks filled with school supplies to children in need. In addition, we also handed out backpacks to visitors of our Basic Needs Program and served a total of 2,000 children with our BTS program!

The Manos de Cristo Annual Report provides a snapshot of 2023 and illustrates how the Central Texas community depends on our programs. With your continued contributions, we will continue to create positive change and inspire our clients to live a healthier and more empowered life.


DENTAL CENTER


BASIC NEEDS

The Gloria & Tony Moreno Basic Needs Center is for those in need of emergency assistance. In 2023, we collaborated with local area churches who donated over 2,125 bags of groceries. Total donations included over 26,383 pounds of food and 257 gift cards! These partnerships have allowed visitors to our Food Pantry to access high-quality food items, including fresh fruits and vegetables that are often considered a luxury. Our Basic Needs Center is dedicated to providing emergency assistance to those in need and can be accessed once every two months to ensure we can serve as many people as possible.





